Discuss *Hillbilly Elegy* With the Pickens Book Club

Join the Pickens Club on Tuesday, April 17 at 10am at the Village Branch Library in Pickens to discuss *Hillbilly Elegy* by J.D. Vance.

Written by a former marine and Yale Law School graduate, *Hillbilly Elegy* is a powerful, first-hand account of growing up in a poor Rust Belt town. J.D. Vance describes and analyzes the decline of white working-class Americans. Vance's own family struggled with the demands of middle-class life and were never able to fully escape from the confines of abuse, alcoholism, poverty, and trauma. Vance shows how he still carries around the demons of his chaotic family history.

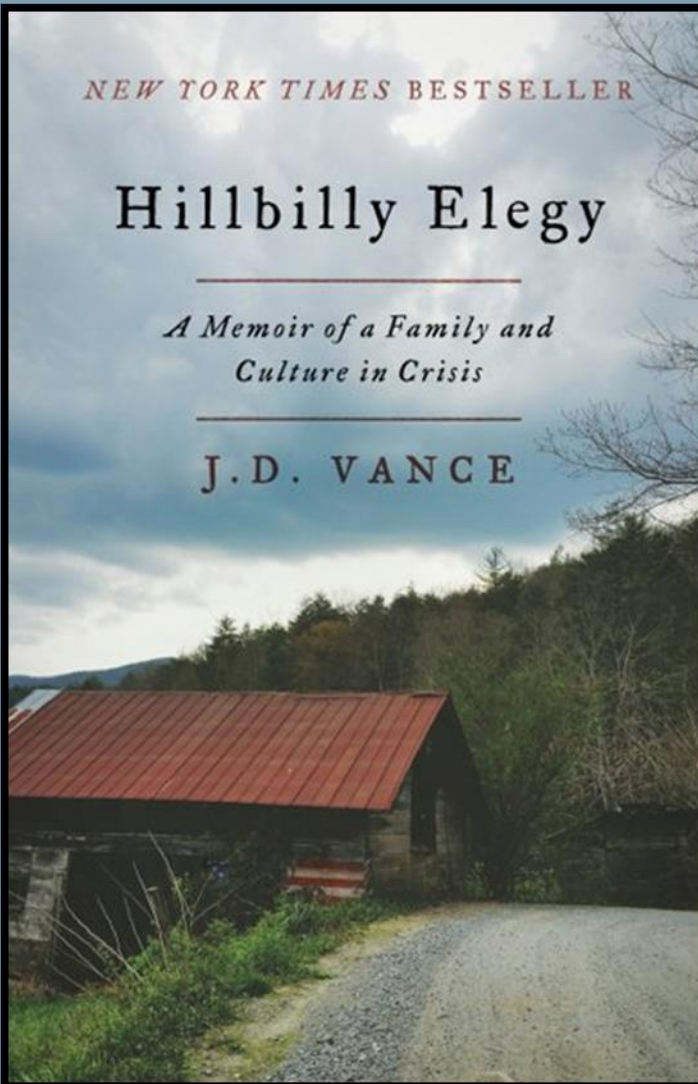
