



## **(ESF 16) Emergency Traffic Management Supervisor Responsibilities:**

Reviews the EOC Common Responsibilities Checklist

Coordinates all law enforcement traffic control operations and crowd control including evacuation

Coordinates law enforcement mutual aid requests

### **Reports to:**

EM Director/EOC Manager

### **Supervises:**

Law Enforcement Traffic Control Specialists

### **Activation Phase:**

- Maintain an overall vision of safety during all processes.
- Initiates position log in WEBEOC
- Activates groups/divisions within law enforcement
- Coordinates mutual aid resources with other law enforcement agencies
- Provides initial law enforcement situation report to the Public Safety Branch Director
- Recommends staffing levels needed within group and requests support
- Establishes communications with law enforcement organizations and procedures for information sharing

### **Operational Phase:**

- Maintains position log in WEBEOC
- Monitors information on the status of law enforcement tasks and reports to Public Safety Branch Director
- Maintains current status on law enforcement activities
- Provides the Public Safety Branch Director with regular summaries of law enforcement operations
- Determines the ancillary facilities and critical infrastructure that require security and ensure security is provided
- Collects, analyzes and shares law enforcement intelligence
- Coordinates traffic and crowd control operations including evacuation
- Determines need for law enforcement mutual aid and places requests
- Determines resources required to meet law enforcement objectives and initiates requests and actions
- Coordinates with other Emergency Support Functions
- Provides law enforcement input to EOC Public Information Officer

### **Demobilization Phase:**

- Ensures any open actions are assigned to appropriate staff

- Provides all final documentation to the Documentation Unit Leader
- Ensures continuity of law enforcement functions throughout and following demobilization

**Unique resources required:**

- Communication device compatible with Incident Command
